Life Recovery Treatment Program (LRTP) offers hope for the hopeless, a way back for the lost, and an opportunity to renew one's life. As a program of the Allentown Rescue Mission, our unique approach combines clinical and cognitive treatment with faith in Jesus Christ.

Since 1997 LRTP has offered **FREE** services. No client is denied services because of funding difficulties. LRTP's focus is on each individual's dedication to treatment and his progress.

- PA licensed, in-patient, residential treatment for men over 18
- Variable length of stay — 42 days or more
- No fees-for clients with funding difficulties
- LRTP accepts referrals from Lehigh, Northampton, Berks, Bucks, Carbon and Monroe counties. Serving Magellan Behavioral Health and the criminal justice system

Treatment and Program Services

LRTP is **group-intensive** — a large portion of each client's day is dedicated to participating in group therapy sessions related to:

- Healing for damaged emotions
- Relapse prevention
- Anger management
- Spirituality and recovery
- Traditional drug and alcohol addiction
12-Step Meetings

LRTP provides a **rich continuum of services** to help lead men to recovery from addiction and return to the community, family, employment, permanent housing and a supportive church if he chooses.

- Individual counseling
- Case management
- On-site psychiatric services
- On-site medical clinic
- Pastoral guidance
- Bible study and chapel services
- NA and AA meetings (on-site or off-site)
- Supervised off-site recreation



Aftercare

Clients can take advantage of other Allentown Rescue Mission services and move forward with paid employment and low-cost housing.

- On-site residential follow-up:
Christian Living and Values Program (no fee)
- Tuition assistance for Lehigh Carbon Community College and Northampton Community College
- Rent-reduced apartments in Allentown — owned and operated by the Allentown Rescue Mission
- Employment with the Mission's Clean Team — paid workforce training
